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Angola



Angola's General Tax Administration announced the gradual rollout of mandatory e-invoicing for most goods and services.

- Deadlines:
 - September 2025: For large businesses: e-invoicing for B2B transactions
 - September 2026: For all businesses: e-invoicing for B2B transactions



France



The French Tax Authority (DGFiP) released initial technical specifications from the AFNOR Commission.

- Deadlines:
 - September 2026: For mid-sized and large businesses: einvoicing for B2B transactions

Latvia



A proposal has been put forward to delay the national e-invoicing mandate to January 1, 2027; the initial deadline was originally set to take effect on January 1, 2026.

- Formats: All formats compliant with the CEN 16931 norm will be accepted
- Deadline:
 - January 2027: For all businesses: e-invoicing for B2B transactions



Malaysia



The implementation of e-invoicing for SMEs with annual sales between RM150,000 and RM500,000 has been postponed to January 1, 2026, accompanied by a six-month transition period.

- Formats: XML, JSON, Peppol PINT
- Deadline:
 - January 2026: For SMEs: e-invoicing for B2B transactions



Nigeria



Beginning July 1, 2025, businesses will be required to issue e-invoices, starting with large taxpayers and gradually expanding to other groups.

- Format: Peppol BIS 3.0.
- Deadline:
 - July 2025: For large businesses: e-invoicing for B2B transactions



Oman



The Omani Tax Authority announced the signing of an e-invoicing agreement with IT infrastructure provider Omantel to implement a nationwide digital invoicing system.

 - January 2026: Voluntary adoption for large businesses: e-invoicing for B2B, B2G, and B2C transactions

Poland



On May 8, 2025, Poland's Ministry of Finance released the draft FA(3) logical structure for the upcoming 2026 KSeF e-invoicing mandate.

 - February 2026: For large businesses: e-invoicing for B2B transactions

Slovakia



Slovakia has recently announced the transition to a decentralized e-invoicing solution using the Peppol network.

Slovenia



The Slovenian Tax Authority (FURS) released a new draft law mandating B2B e-invoicing, postponing its implementation from June 2026 to January 2027.

- Formats: e-SLOG, UBL, 2.1, UNCEFACT CII, all formats compliant with the CEN 16931 norm will be accepted
- Deadline:
 - January 2027: For all businesses: e-invoicing and ereporting for both B2B and B2C transactions



Spain



The Spanish Tax Authority (AEAT) has published new public information outlining modifications to the upcoming e-invoicing mandate, Ley Crea y Crece.

- E-invoicing system: Public Platform (not yet defined).
- Format: UBL (to reach the Public Platform)
- Deadlines:
 - 2027 (TBD): For large businesses: e-invoicing for B2B transactions
 - 2028 (TBD): For all businesses: e-invoicing for B2B transactions



United Arab Emirates



The UAE introduced and presented the e-invoicing Service Providers Accreditation Portal to potential service providers in the country.

 - Q2 2026: Phase 1 go-live of e-invoicing reporting obligation



United Kingdom



HM Revenue & Customs and the Department for Business and Trade have opened a public consultation on e-invoicing for B2B and B2G transactions in the UK, aiming to explore its potential benefits for British businesses and assess different e-invoicing models.
